ROAD CLOSURE ADVICE: 2022 HERALD SUN / TRANSURBAN RUN FOR THE KIDS

Herald Sun/ Transurban Run for the Kids is coming up on Sunday 3 April 2022 and we want to ensure that you're aware of the impact the event may have on you.

On 3 April, there will be several road closures to manage participant and spectator movements during the event.

Our objective is to close roads for the shortest possible time, and we are focused on minimising disruption wherever possible. There will be a significant impact on traffic in and around the course during the event, with road closures in place to ensure the safety of participants. There is no parking on the course itself during the road closure period. At all times emergency access and the movement of emergency vehicles takes priority.

Please see below specific considerations that relate to the New Quay Promenade/Waterfront City: 1:30am – 12 midday

Access to New Quay Promenade/ Waterfront City is possible from Footscray Road via Waterfront Way ONLY and traffic controllers will be on location to assist. Pearl River Road will be closed between 1:30am-12 midday. Docklands Drive will be closed in both directions from Harbour Esplanade to Pearl River Road from 1:30am until 12 midday, other than to facilitate access during the below times for those south or west of Docklands Drive. There will be limited local access across Docklands Drive via Doepel Way and Waterfront Way only, but only before 07:30am, between races from 09:00am - 09:20am and then after 10:15am.

Please see below specific considerations that relate to Harbour Esplanade and Victoria Harbour: 1:30am – 2:30pm

 VEHICLE ACCESS - - - - -

Harbour Esplanade will be closed from 1:30am until 2:30pm in both directions from Charles Grimes Bridge to Footscray Rd. From 1:30am there will be no access into Docklands and Victoria Harbour using Charles Grimes Bridge. The Charles Grimes Bridge closure will remain in place until 2.30pm. Victoria Harbour will be accessible for local traffic throughout, via Bourke Street only. Traffic controllers will be on location to manage access requirements. Collins Street will be closed in both directions between Navigation Drive and Spencer Street.
